# 1. M.A. IPEEA Programme admission and procedure

- Admission requirements
  - Bachelor's Degree in <u>Economics and Politics of East Asia</u>
  - The following Bachelor's Degrees also qualify for admission to the M.A. IPEEA programme
    - B.A. programmes with a regional focus on East Asia
    - Language training in an East Asian language
    - Social or political science orientation (only after prior equivalency review by the student advisors)



## 1. M.A. IPEEA Programme admission and procedure

- Admission documents
  - Short cover letter
  - Curriculum vitae (CV)
  - List of academic achievements (certificates and transcript of records)
  - Language/s proficiency result/s
- ✓ Please send all documents compiled in one single PDF file to ma-ipeea-counselling@ruhr-uni-bochum.de
  - If all documents are acceptable, the M.A.IPEEA Academic Advisors will schedule a consultation meeting for an interview and explanation of the programme.
    - Confirmation document: Proof of a <u>mandatory</u> advisory interview (consultation meeting) with the **M.A. IPEEA Academic Advisors** and acceptance of applicant into the M.A. IPEEA. **This document will be necessary for enrolment.**



   Japanese or Korean language studies










Step 6



  - Send all documents required to ma-ipeea-counselling@ruhr-uni-bochum.de
  - University transfer students\* <u>must</u> apply for recognition of the equivalence of their Bachelor's degree
  - Proof of a <u>mandatory</u> advisory interview (consultation meeting) with the **M.A. IPEEA Academic advisors** 
    - After a consultation session and revision of the student application, successful candidates will receive the following document: "Stellungnahmezur Gleichwertigkeit des Hochschulabschlusses zur Erteilung der Zulassung zum Studium des"

\*Note: "University transfer students" refers to students from another university in Germany



- After submission of the Online application
  - → Upload all the application documents\* in the **Infoportal** incl.
    - Proof of language proficiency (German)
    - Certified copy of degree certificate (original language and German and/or English translation)
    - Possible proof of other language skills (original language and English and/or German translation)
    - Transcript of records (if applicable)
    - Copy of the passport
    - APS certificate (only for applicants from China or Vietnam)
      - Please note collective APS for other universities are not accepted!
    - Registrar's Office will register you to the M.A. IPEEA upon application within the re-registration deadlines
      - Note: registration is only possible for Winter Semester

### 3.2 M.A. IPEEA Programme application – External students (German university)

- Changing to a graduate programme
  - Send all documents required to ma-ipeea-counselling@ruhr-uni-bochum.de
  - University transfer students\* must apply for recognition of the equivalence of their Bachelor's degree
  - If all documents are acceptable (see admission documents), Academic Advisors will schedule a consultation meeting for an interview and explanation of the programme
  - Registrar's Office will register you to the M.A. IPEEA upon application
    - Bachelor's degree and transcript of records
    - Proof of a mandatory advisory interview (consultation meeting) with the M.A. IPEEA Academic Advisors
    - After a consultation session and revision of the student application, successful candidates will receive the following document: "Bescheinigung über Das/Die Beratungsgespräch/e\* Vor Aufnahme der Masterphase des gestuften B.A./M.A. Studienganges Zur Vorlage im Studierendensekretariat der RUB"

\*Note: "University transfer students" refers to students from another university in Germany

- Changing to a graduate programme
  - Registrar's Office will register you to the M.A. IPEEA upon application
    - Bachelor's degree and transcript of records
    - Proof of a <u>mandatory</u> advisory interview (consultation meeting) with the **M.A. IPEEA Academic**

- After a consultation session and revision of the student application, successful candidates will receive a Consultation Letter ("Bescheinigung über Das/Die Beratungsgespräch/e\* Vor Aufnahme der Masterphase des gestuften B.A./M.A. Studienganges Zur Vorlage im Studierendensekretariat der RUB")
- Registration is possible for Winter and Summer Semester. Consult the M.A. IPEEA Academic
   Advisors for clarifications regarding timing
